ALL EVENTS

Per Capita fees and other payments together with all required documentation must be sent to the MSA within 14 days after each event [D26.4]. Failure to do so may, in addition to late payment fee, invoke penalties as set out in C2.

PUBLIC HIGHWAY EVENTS – Motor Vehicles (Competitions & Trials) Regulations 1969 (as amended)

PER CAPITA FEES

INSURANCE

CANCELLATION

If for whatever reason the competition for which this permit is issued is cancelled or postponed this form must be returned immediately. Failure to do so may result in a charge of up to £1,000 being levied. NB Certificate of Exemptions, 12 Car and Scatter Rally fees are only refundable under extraordinary circumstances.
