INSURANCE INFO AND SOME SAFETY TIPS

A short note to all members new and old to try to answer some of the more commonly asked questions about insurance and safety.

Nothing too in depth, just a few commonsense guidelines to follow:

- 1 The MSA insurance we have on our off road sites is public liability insurance and does not cover any damage done to your or any other persons vehicle on the site
- 2 All drivers on the site should make sure they are insured to be driving that vehicle in an off road situation
- 3 Most insurers will not insure a vehicle unless it has a current MOT. If it hasn't, you're not insured.
- 4 Don't push you or your vehicle past their limitations
- 5 Know where the first aid point is on the site that day
- 6 Wear seatbelts including all passengers
- 7 10 MPH maximum speed limit to be observed at all times
- 8 Have a working fire extinguisher and first aid box securely fastened in the vehicle
- 9 Store any heavy items such as shackles, jacks etc. securely
- 10 Make sure you have strong recovery point's front and back, preferably two front and back as a rope attached to both halves the strain on each point
- 11 Have good condition recovery ropes etc. and never join two ropes with a shackle in the middle in case one breaks
- 12 Never lay a shackle loosely over a tow ball
- 13 If you are not sure, ask other members for help
- 14 Make sure you and all around you have a fun day out, BE SAFE
